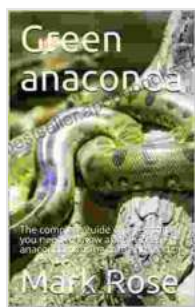

Enclosure Size

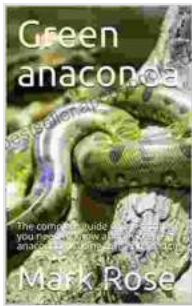
